


How to Access AcornTV

To get to the login page for AcornTV either go to the Digital Media page on our website, under Services, or go to bethelct.rbdigital.com




If you are accessing AcornTV for the first time you will need to click Register at the top right. You will then be prompted to set-up your login information and personal information for your account. Click Register when finished.



Once you are logged in, you will see the AcornTV logo which you will click on to browse what titles are available. There is also a menu at the top left of the window where once it expands you can go to your account, see what you have checked out through rbDigital, and logout.

To start, click on any show and it will lead you to a page where you can choose to “checkout” the show. Note that if you are a returning user, it may say Access instead of Checkout.


You now have UNLIMITED access to ALL of Acorn TV for 7 days!

After you access Acorn TV, you can search for and select this series, or choose from many others. When your access expires, you may return to RBdigital to check out another 7-day pass.




Click ok, and then you will see an Access button where Checkout used to be. Click on Access, and it will bring you the regular AcornTV website, where you can browse shows, and begin watching them.



Sometimes it may have you log into your account again after you click access, which will be on this screen:



To begin watching an episode, click on the series, then at the bottom it will show you all of the available episodes. Click on the episode you'd like to begin.



It will open a new page and you can click the play button to start the episode. There is also an option for controlling the volume, closed captioning, and full screen view at the bottom of the video.
