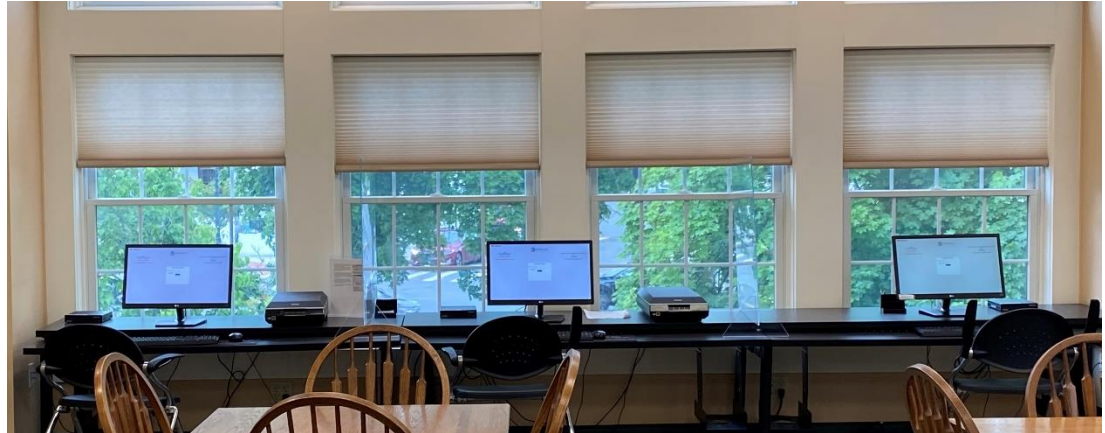


Director's Report
